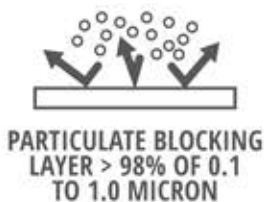
# OHIO HOODS INITIATIVE CITY OF MARION FIRE DEPARTMENT
